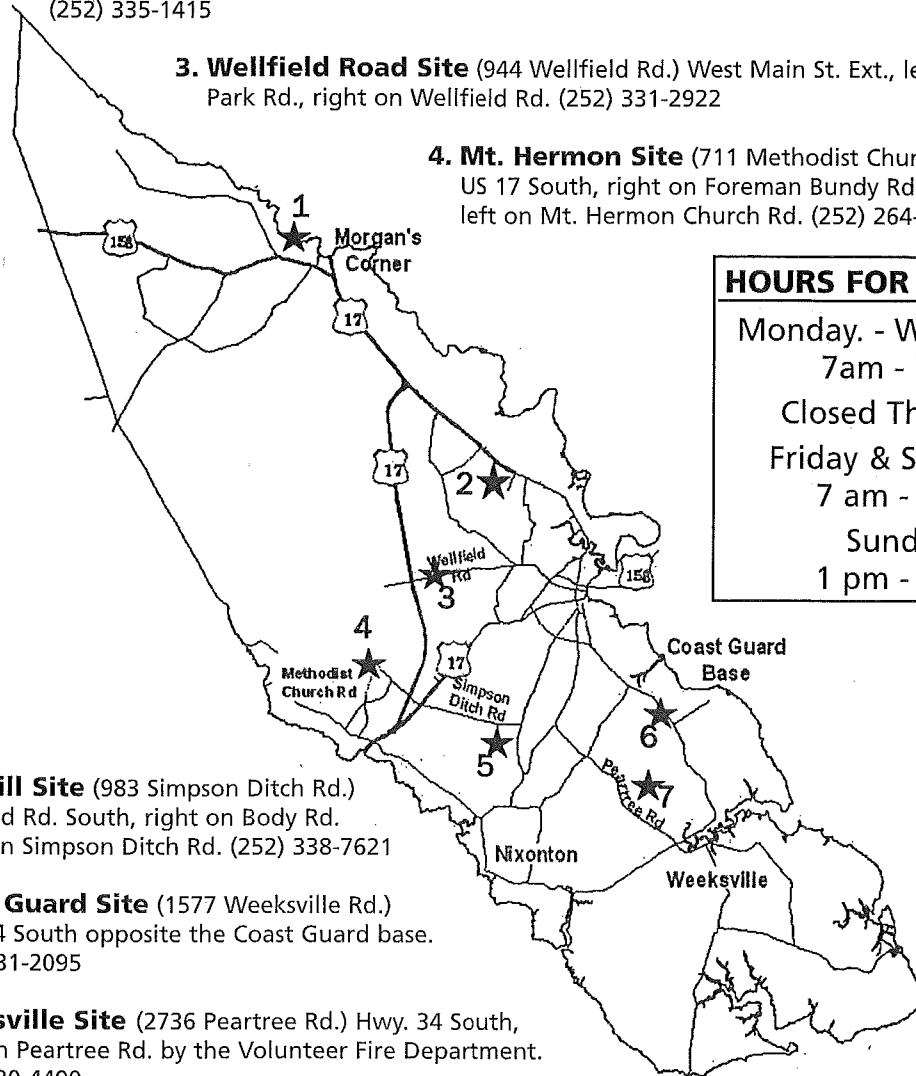
From Downtown Elizabeth City, Follow These Directions To the Sites

# ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

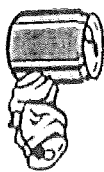


## — MIXED CONTAINER PRODUCTS —



### ALUMINUM

All Sites



Accepted: Aluminum beverage/food cans, please rinse & crush.  
Not accepted: Pie plates, aluminum foil, and any cans contaminated with food.

### PLASTICS

All Sites



Accepted: Clear plastic bottles with number 1 or 2 inside "chasing arrow" symbol. Please remove lids and flatten to save space.  
Not Accepted: Tubs are not accepted, even if labeled with 1 or 2, as well as containers contaminated with food.

### STEEL CANS

All Sites

Accepted: All steel food cans. Test with magnet if unsure about material and please rinse.

Not Accepted: Cans contaminated with food. Aluminum cans should be sorted and recycled separately.

### MIXED GLASS (not mixed with other materials)

All Sites



Accepted: Clear, brown, and green glass bottles and food jars.

Not Accepted: Window glass, light bulbs, crystal, ceramic, or cookware.

### YARD WASTE

All Sites



Accepted: Yard Waste less than 100 pounds and limbs less than 8 feet long and 4 inches in diameter.

Not Accepted: Yard Waste greater than above should be taken to the Land Clearing and Inert Debris area on Simpson Ditch Road.

## — MIXED PAPER PRODUCTS —

The four products contained are cardboard, office mix, magazines and newspaper.



### CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

All Sites



Accepted: Cardboard boxes.

Not Accepted: Plastic film, Styrofoam, laminated coatings, or wet and food-soiled boxes.

Preparation: Flatten to save space.

### MAGAZINES/NEWSPAPER

All Sites



Accepted: Magazines, Catalogs, and clean dry newspaper with inserts.

Not Accepted: All other paper types should be recycled separately.

### OFFICE PAPER

All Sites

Accepted: Copy paper, greeting cards, pamphlets, manila file folders, telephone books, white envelopes with windows and carbonless forms.

Not Accepted: Bright colored paper, brown kraft envelopes, chipboard, sticky labels and plastics. All other paper types should be recycled separately.

### TELEPHONE BOOKS

All Sites



Accepted: Used telephone books.

Not Accepted: All other paper types should be recycled separately.

### WHITE GOODS/MIXED METALS

All Sites



Accepted: Old appliances such as air conditioners, washing machines, dryers and refrigerators.

Not Accepted: Television sets, stereos, and small kitchen appliances.

## — AUTOMOTIVE PRODUCTS —

### ANTI-FREEZE

Newland & Landfill Sites Only

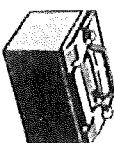
Accepted: Used anti-freeze from cars & other vehicles.

Not Accepted: Used anti-freeze contaminated with other material.



### LEAD ACID BATTERIES

All Sites



Accepted: Batteries from cars and trucks.

Not Accepted: Household batteries. (dry cell and nickel-cadmium.)

Preparation: Store intact. If possible, exchange when purchasing new battery.

### MOTOR OIL

All Sites



Accepted: Used oil from cars and other vehicles.

Not Accepted: Oil contaminated with anti-freeze or other materials.

### TIRES

Newland & Landfill Sites Only

Accepted: Truck and car tires from personal vehicles.

Not Accepted: Tire dealers should arrange for a special collection procedure with Solid Waste Director by calling 335-4105.

Preparation: Tires must be taken off the rim and free of grease and mud.



### C&D WASTE

All Sites

Accepted: All household wood, construction and remodeling debris.

Not Accepted: Waste and debris from contractors or commercial establishments.
