You can bring all of these items to the sites: recyclables, yard waste, scrap metals, appliances, furnishings, household waste, motor oil, oil filters, and antifreeze. Swap shops are open daylight hrs. Tires should be left at the dealer where the new tires are purchased or taken to the PCG Landfill.

SWAP IT at the swap shop at the Sunbury site. Bring gently worn household goods, furniture, books, tools, etc. and look for something you can use. Please no clothes, paint, or hazardous materials. The shop is open during daylight hours.

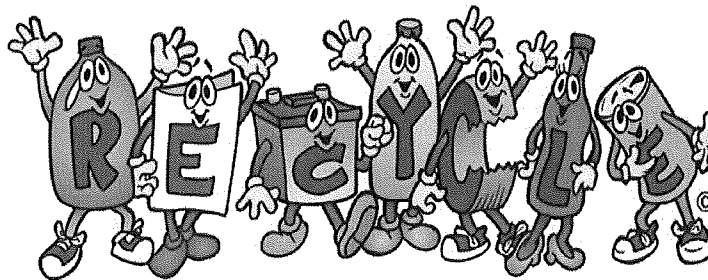

What Goes Into the Recycling Compactor?

- All plastic bottles
- Cardboard
- Aluminum Cans
- Steel Cans
- Newspaper
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Mail
- Office paper
- Paperboard (cereal, shoe boxes)
- Paper bags
- Phone books

Please keep glass separate.

Please place glass into the glass recycling container. No need to separate it by colors. Windows, mirrors, and ceramics are now allowed.

Look at the "glasscrete" pad for the compactor at the Roduco Site. **It contains 10.5 tons of glass that our local residents recycled.** A factory in Elizabeth City makes all of the glass collected into paving products and other items.



All Plastic Bottles Are Now Collected!

DO include

these kinds of empty plastic bottles:
Bathroom, laundry, and cleaning supplies, food & beverage bottles



DON'T include

these kinds of plastic items:

Bags, plastic wrap, toys, cups, Styrofoam, Motor oil containers, tubs, pails, flowerpots, microwave containers
